McMaster University, 1: The Toronto Years, by Charles M. Johnston (University of Toronto Press, 1976. xvi, 295 pp. £9.75) tells how the university was established in 1887 as a trust of the Canadian Baptist constituency and how the first forty years were darkened by theological and educational conflicts. A second volume, now in preparation, will describe the years in Hamilton.

The Journal of George Fox, edited by John L. Nickalls, with an epilogue by Henry J. Cadbury and an introduction by Geoffrey F. Nuttall, first published by Cambridge University Press in 1952, has been re-issued with minor corrections by the Society of Friends, and is available from the Friends Book Centre, Friends House, Euston Road, London, N.W.1, price £4.00 hardback, £2.85 paperback.

Methodism, by Rupert E. Davies, first published by Penguin Books in 1963, has been revised and brought up to date. The new edition is published by the Epworth Press, price £1.75 (paperback, 196 pp.).
